SEVEN BASIC NEEDS

1. THE NEED FOR SHELTER AND FOOD..
2. THE NEED TO BELIEVE LIFE IS MEANINGFUL AND HAS A PURPOSE.
3. THE NEED FOR A SENSE OF COMMUNITY AND DEEPER RELATIONSHIP.
4. THE NEED TO BE APPRECIATED AND RESPECTED.
5. THE NEED TO BE LISTENED TO AND TO BE HEARD.
6. THE NEED TO FEEL ONE IS GROWING IN THEIR FAITH.
7. THE NEED FOR PRACTICAL HELP IN DEVELOPING A MATURE FAITH.

- **CAN THE CHURCH COUNT ON MY AFFECTION? (1 CHRONICLES 29:1-3)**

DAVID GAVE TO GOD'S HOUSE BECAUSE HE LOVED GOD'S HOUSE.

QUESTION: DO YOU LOVE GRACE CHAPEL?

YOU CAN GIVE WITHOUT LOVING BUT YOU CANNOT LOVE WITHOUT GIVING.

- **CAN THE CHURCH COUNT ON MY ALLEGIANCE? (NEHEMIAH 10:39)**

THE WORD *FORSAKE* MEANS: "TO LET GO"; "TO LET LOOSE"; "TO DESERT"; "TO NEGLECT", "TO ABANDON."

WE FORSAKE BY: NOT SHOWING UP; SHOWING UP WHEN CONVENIENT, DRAGGING IN, BAD ATTITUDE WHICH RESULTS IN BAD ACTIONS.

- **CAN THE CHURCH COUNT ON MY attendance? (Hebrews 10:24-25).**

YOU NOT ONLY OUGHT TO DEFEND YOUR CHURCH AND COMMEND YOUR CHURCH AND RECOMMEND YOUR CHURCH, BUT YOU NEED TO ATTEND YOUR CHURCH.

THREE QUESTIONS

IS MY AFFECTION UP TO DATE?

IS MY ALLEGIANCE UP TO DATE?

IS MY ATTENDANCE UP TO DATE?
