We were born for greatness. Greatness is your inheritance. God has placed seeds of greatness in you. We have unlimited potential.

Lessons may be defined as, "an amount of teaching given at a specific time; a period of learning or teaching."

Principle # 1: We need to be Accessible! (Vs. 1-2)

The word accessible means, "In a place where one can be reached, obtained, understood, appreciated, or approached..."

Being accessible is to be in the right place, at the right time... It's being rightly positioned so that one can be used...

Principle # 2: We need to be Available! (Vs.3-5)

The word available means, "Able to be used or obtained; at someone's disposal; free and/or willing to do something..."

Accessibility is being at the right place, at the right time...

Availability is being willing to be used once you are accessed...

Principle # 3: We need to be Accommodating! (Vs. 6-7)

The word accommodating means, "fitting in with someone's wishes or demands in a helpful way **by changing his or her plans**; willing to help you out; it's used to describe those who are cheerfully willing to make small adjustments; be cooperative..."

Accessible is being at the right place, at the right time—Available is to be willing to be used - Accommodating is to cooperate or "act right" when you are used...
