	foolish orbefore the Lord.
	 Our heavenly Father loves us with an extravagant abandon.
	Passionate, undignified worship is our only response.
	Principle: God loves the extravagance of a worshipper.
	Principle: What's stored up in our hearts we sing, and and live.
	Principle: David's worship and dance was an overflow of the
	of love for God that was in his heart.
	Principle: An undignified worshipper loses themselves in the wonder,
	and praise for God.
4.	Unpredictable Worshipper (Mark 14:1-9)
	Principle: An unpredictable worshipper is one who does not know the
