Key Truth: Renegade Christian is a rebel with a purpose – someone who rises up against resistance and mediocrity.

Key Question: The question is not are you a follower of Jesus; the question is how close are you following Jesus?

Key Truth: The sheep closest to the Shepherd gets the most fruit.

Three Principles of a renegade Christian

1. Proclaiming (Luke 2:17-18)

- If we treasure the treasure we will share the treasure with others.
- The shepherds told everyone they met what they had seen and heard.

2. Pondering (Luke 2:19)

- Ponder means to reflect deeply; to chew the cud; to elaborate; to weigh in the mind.
- Pondering is hard work.
- The better you are at looking back, the more equipped you will be to look forward.

3. Praising (Luke 2:20)

- You “glorify” anything when you recognize its true value.

Conclusion

- **Proclaim** the good news that Christ has come.
- **Ponder** the works of God
- **Praise** God in our daily lives.
